**IN SUPPORT OF FUNDING**  
**FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MARLINS STADIUM**

The undersigned President of the Latin Chamber of Commerce U.S.A., CAMACOL, a Florida nonprofit corporation, does hereby certify that the following resolution was duly adopted:

**WHEREAS**, the "Global Agreement" between the City of Miami and Miami-Dade County provides a funding mechanism for the financing of such important community projects as a new baseball stadium for the Florida Marlins, Port of Miami tunnel, and other infrastructure improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, CAMACOL envisions the future construction of the baseball stadium on the former Orange Bowl site in the Little Havana neighborhood in the City of Miami as a source of new economic development for the neighborhood; and

**WHEREAS**, CAMACOL understands the surge in community cohesiveness and pride that are born of major community events such as an All-Star game or World Series; and

**WHEREAS**, CAMACOL fully supports the use of tourism tax dollars and General Obligation Bond funds for the proposed baseball stadium for the Florida Marlins and it is gratified by the recent court ruling declaring that the construction of a baseball stadium satisfies a legal test of public purpose sufficient to allow for public financing and use of public dollars; and


**WHEREAS**, this investment in the future of Miami will spur economic growth and vitality and send a strong message of confidence in the future of this region, particularly the area of Little Havana;
